

DIVINE MERCY NOVENA AND CHAPLET



2021 Schedule for The Divine Mercy Novena

What is a novena? A novena is a prayer for a certain intention repeated for 9 consecutive days (or weeks). The prayer we repeat for this novena is The Chaplet of The Divine Mercy. The chaplet is prayed using an ordinary rosary. On the “Our Father” beads we pray: Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world. On the “Hail Mary” beads we pray: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Why do we pray as a group? We pray The Divine Mercy Novena as a group to grow spiritually together, to learn and deepen our faith, and to go out in love to serve one another. Can I pray the novena on my own? Yes, you can pray the novena on your own. We suggest that you do so on the same schedule as the group prays so that we can be spiritually united in prayer.

The group meets in the church. The schedule for this year is:

Day 1 – Good Friday, April 2 at 9 a.m.

Day 2 – Holy Saturday, April 3 at 9 a.m.

Day 3 – Easter Sunday, April 4 – Pray at home. No group meeting.

Day 4 – Monday April 5th thru Day 9 Saturday April 10th is at 9 a.m.

The end of the novena is celebrated on The Divine Mercy Sunday, (April 11), with one Hour of Adoration at 2 p.m., the Chaplet at 3 p.m. and Benediction.
